Debates on Rehabilitation: The Idea, Research, and Vectors of Development

The conference will be held in stationary form on 18 May 2022 on site at the University of Warsaw Library (BUW)

The conference is one of the events organized to mark:

- the 50th anniversary of the Institute of Social Prevention and Rehabilitation,
 University of Warsaw;
- the 50th anniversary of the Department of Rehabilitation Pedagogy at the Institute of Social Prevention and Rehabilitation, University of Warsaw.

The Institute of Social Prevention and Rehabilitation (IPSiR) was Poland's first independent extra-faculty institute, established at the University of Warsaw for the purpose of research on social pathologies and problems. It is an interdisciplinary research and educational unit with unique achievements and tradition, gathering together scholars and academic teachers specializing in disciplines such as sociology, law, pedagogy, psychology, criminology, and others.

The aim of the conference is to enable an exchange of ideas based on presentations delivered by the invited experts (Polish and international), devoted to prevention and rehabilitation activities, the directions of their development and their effectiveness and based on empirical data, good practices, and evaluations.

Consequently, the broad spectrum of topics for debate covers issues such as:

- the theory and methodology of rehabilitation (care education therapy);
- the relevance of the work of Czesław Czapów and Stanisław Jedlewski the originators of the Warsaw school of rehabilitation pedagogy;
- the determinants of social maladjustment;
- the consistency of procedures for assessing designing implementing and evaluating the effectiveness of rehabilitation interventions;
- recommending theories and methods of rehabilitation based on empirical data (evidence-based approach);
- the presentation of well-tested methodological solutions (good practices), supported by their evaluation.

It is worth noting that the title of the conference includes the phrase "vectors of development," alluding to Czesław Czapów's work and at the same time suggesting the directions of development in rehabilitation. Accordingly, the preferred approaches in the debate are interdisciplinary, evolutionary, and comparative perspectives.

Conference Formula

The conference has the form of a debate, which means that, apart from presentations by experts (five speakers from Poland and other countries), its equally important element is the opportunity for participants, inspired by the issues raised, to exchange views and experiences.

After the presentations, each person attending the conference will have the opportunity to speak in the debate, chaired by experts acting as moderators. To enable a substantive and exhaustive exchange of reflections, views, and experiences, the organizers have planned a considerable amount of time for discussion in each session.

The language of the conference is Polish. The presentations delivered by foreign

guests will be professionally interpreted into Polish and the voices in the debate will

be interpreted into English.
